## Summer Reminders

### Confirm and Participate in Summer Fire Drill

## GNA VIOLATIONS THIS YEAR

TRASH | DUMPSTERS | LAWNS

Since June 2015, there have been 46 total GNA Violations (YTD: 65)

Trash Violations: 22; only 3 violations since November (YTD: 41)

Dumpster Violations: 24; only 2 violations since January (YTD: 24)

## GNA Year in Review 2015-2016

- 58% of Dumpster Violations came from the same three dumpsters. They were the only dumpsters with more than two total Dumpster Violations this year.
- Only three fraternity chapters had more than two total Trash Violations this year (Trash Violations decreased by 19 incidents).
- Total number of Violations **decreased by 30%** from last year (65 total Violations occurred in 2014-2015 school year).

72% of Trash Violations occur on Fridays

71% of Dumpster Violations occur on Tuesdays or Wednesdays
